Lent and Beyond

Upper Room Ministries on-line gives a good explanation of Lent 101. If you are not familiar with Lent as a season of the Christian calendar, then let me explain. You have probably heard people saying, "I'm giving _____ up for Lent." Yes, there are people who do that. The reason for giving something up is to make room for more of God. This practice is called *fasting*. I have fasted at times in my life. It does not have to be chocolate. You can fast from Facebook or TV. Anything that takes time away from God is a good thing to give up for Lent. You can also add something to your life that makes time for God, like walking, meditating, or studying the Bible.

When is Lent? It is the forty days before Easter. Lent excludes Sundays, because every Sunday is like a little Easter. Basically, it's about one-tenth of a year (like a tithe of time). Mardi Gras is the day before Lent, which begins with Ash Wednesday. This year it's from March 1 (Ash Wednesday) to April 16 (Easter), 2017.

At Bethany, our study during Lent is a book entitled "Gifts of the Dark Wood" by Eric Elnes. This spiritual reading explores events that happen in our lives and how we can find God in even difficult and painful experiences. The Sunday Morning Adult Discussion group will study in depth the concepts that Eric Elnes presents. Our worship experience during Lent will also reflect on Elnes' concepts.

We will "EMERGE" after Lent into Easter and the season that follows. According to Marcia McFee of the Worship Design Studio, "EMERGE" features the image of the butterfly that has long been a symbol of the resurrection of Jesus as well as the resurrection of believers as we emerge from the power of death. "EMERGE" examines our own transformations from cocoons and tombs to the unfurled beauty of all God calls us to be.


