

Pastor Colleen is the Western North Carolina Association Minister of Church Affairs

Rev. Colleen Samson was selected as the Western North Carolina Association (WNCA) Minister of Church Affairs (MCA). Responsibilities for her new ministry began on February 20. She will now be half-time at Bethany and half-time with the WNCA. She will oversee 65 churches and about 350 clergy including active local pastors, chaplains, and retired ministers. Her new responsibilities also include consultation with the Committee on Ministry and the WNCA Board of Directors. Pastor Colleen will be a pastor to the pastors of the WNCA.

You may be wondering how Pastor Colleen's work at Bethany will change. The council is working on a plan and hopefully will soon have something to present to the congregation. Until that time, there will not be any noticeable change.

Rev. Dr. Edward Davis, Southern Conference Minister, will install Rev. Samson to her new position. A date for the installation has not yet been announced. The congregation will be informed when a date is chosen.


Maundy Thursday Service will be held at Peace UCC in Hickory, NC on March 29 at 7:00pm.
