From the Pastor's Desk – Preparing for Ministry

"Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness..." – Matthew 4:1

Rooted in the 40 days Jesus spent in the wilderness after his baptism, the spiritual practice of giving something up for Lent mirrors Jesus' time in the wilderness before his ministry began. Throughout the years since then, many Christians have taken this season as an opportunity to fast and reflect in ways which will enhance their spiritual life and prepare them for the ministry yet to come. Sometimes, giving something up is what we need to make room to listen to God's Spirit more intentionally. 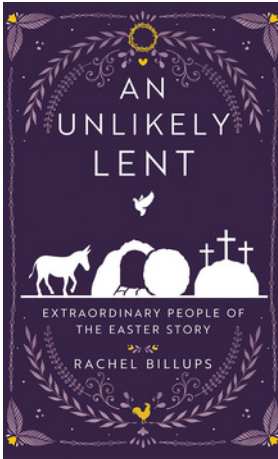
