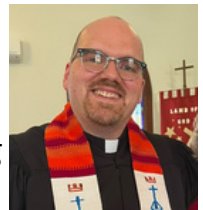

On our way back to the car, we sat across from two women. They were holding a very tired child and had arms filled with bags.
